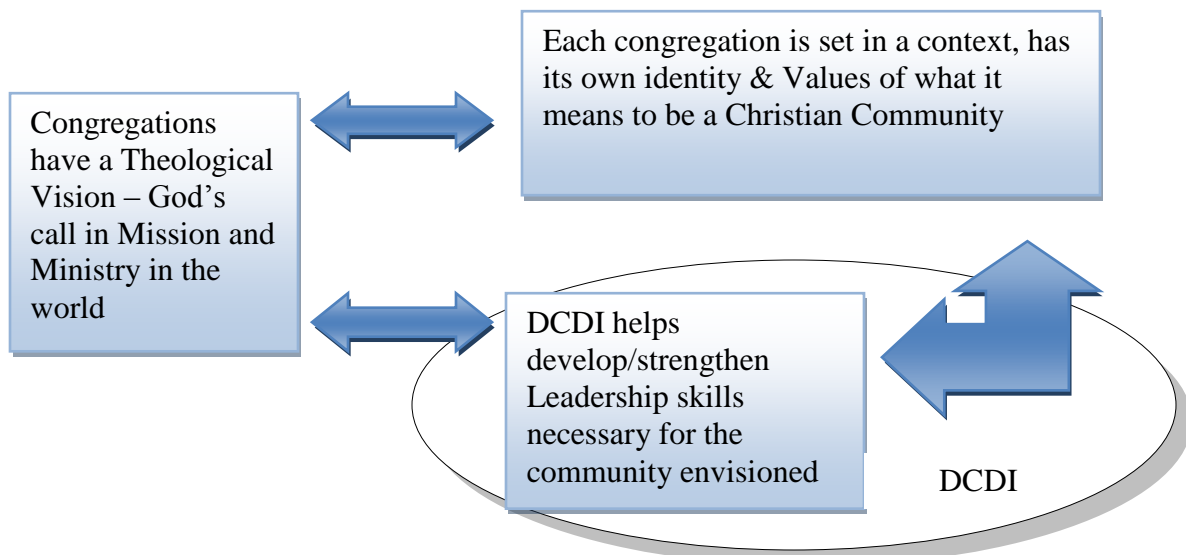


Registration for Diocesan Church Development Institute (DCDI) 2014-2015 Saturday/ Sunday Classes

What is Diocesan Church Development Institute (DCDI) in a nutshell? Below is a model to show what we are highlighting at CDI. Each element is shaped by the other. Our goal is not only to help leaders know and see how their community is called, but also how to plan and strengthen leadership skills for this Godly mission/vision.



We train parish teams in leadership development. We are all working toward bringing people to know God through Jesus, yet we have our own individual and community ways of doing that. Our goal is to help people ask questions, look at things in new ways and to be intentional in their planning. If you would like to be a part of our next training cycle the time is now to sign up.

This next cycle will be a Saturday - Sunday format. This new format gives us the opportunity to invite people who cannot take a Friday off and lets us experience Morning Prayer not only at DCDI but also at our home parishes if we choose.  - Coming prepared with a: willingness to participate, to learn, to try, to fail, to succeed, to share, to laugh and to have fun.
