Our Privacy Policy

The Diocese of Milwaukee is committed to safeguarding the privacy of visitors and customers to our website. To protect your privacy, we have set security measures in place to protect the loss, misuse, and alteration of the information under our control, gathered from our website. Our SSL technology ensures the secure identity of our customers' computers, protecting your information when you use our online registration, application, or product ordering features.

This Statement of Privacy applies to the Episcopal Diocese of Milwaukee website and governs data collection and usage. By using the Episcopal Diocese of Milwaukee website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

The Information We Collect

We require you to provide us with certain information about yourself when you request or access certain features, products, and services from this site. We also collect information from you when you participate in any diocesan surveys and online discussions, or when you respond to requests for feedback.

The information we collect may include information from which you may be personally identified, such as name, mailing address, telephone numbers, fax number, and e-mail address. All credit card and e-check transactions are handled through a secure gateway, which means credit card numbers and related information are not collected or stored on the Diocese of Milwaukee site.

How We Use Your Information

If you do provide us with personal information, we will abide by any limitation on the purposes for which it will be used that is expressed where it is collected, and we will not sell, license, transmit or disclose this information outside of the Diocese of Milwaukee unless (1) you expressly authorize us to do so, or (2) it is necessary to allow our contractors or agents to provide services for us, or (3) in order to provide products or services to you, or (4) otherwise as required or permitted by law.

We publish an email newsletter E-News. Information collected in the process of subscribing to the newsletter or other diocesan sponsored lists and social media is not shared with any other organization or individual except for the reasons given above.

We restrict access to personal information collected about you at our website to our employees, our affiliates' employees, or others who need to know that information to provide services to you or in the course of conducting our normal business operations. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect personal information.
